

MONTVALE FIRE DEPARTMENT SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Montvale Fire Department offers this Scholarship Award to help in a student's advancement to a better education and achievement of their goals, the same as we in the Volunteer Fire Department try to help our neighbors in their time of need.

Listed below are the rules and guidelines for this award.

- 1) Only graduating high school student (seniors) residing in the Borough of Montvale are eligible to apply and receive the award.
- 2) Consideration for the award will be given only to those students who submit a completed official application by the indicated closing date, which is written at the top of the application form.
- 3) The scholarship award will be made at the annual awards ceremony of the high school.
- 4) Completed applications are to be returned to the school office, Montvale Borough Hall or the Montvale Fire Department.
- 5) Any information submitted to the Scholarship Committee by an applicant or his/her family will be held in complete confidence.
- 6) Grades of grade averages are not the sole factor in selecting a winner for the award. Other factors such as need, character, ambition, volunteer/scouts service, etc.
- 7) Acceptance to at least 1 College/University.
- 8) Scholarship is \$750. 00 per year times # years of schooling (normal schedule). Max 4 years or \$3000.
